## FLOOR TILES

Accessorize your sauna with beautiful cedar floor tiles. Each floor tile covers approximately two square feet of floor space in your sauna. The tile is constructed from Western Red Cedar, making it naturally resistant to moisture that can be present in sauna environments. Each tile has rounded edges on all four sides, enhancing the comfort of the naturally soft cedar wood. Place the tile on any flat surface and combine multiple tiles to create vertical, horizontal, basket weave, or random flooring patterns, depending on your preference. Simply cut the tile on a table saw if you need to adjust the size for your specific sauna floorplan. The tile also works great in any diameter barrel sauna. For a barrel sauna, place the tiles along the length of the sauna to create a flat floor that allows water to drain through. Tiles can be easily removed for periodic cleaning, which can be done with gentle pressure washing or simply wiping down with a vinegar and water solution. Sauna floor tiles are the ideal addition to your sauna to beautify and enhance your sauna experience!

- Each tile measures 17" x 17" x 1.25"
- Tiles weigh approximately 3.5lbs each
- A single tile covers approximately two square feet of floor space
- Designed for stable support when walking on the tiles
- Western red cedar construction • 1/8" spacing between each tile to allow for draining
- Rounded edges on all 4 sides of each tile for added comfort

## MAINTENANCE

To clean your floor tiles, use a mixture of one-part white vinegar to 3-parts water, scrubbing the wood with a brush and then rinsing with clean water. For extra dirty tiles you can power wash the tiles with a wide pattern and gentle pressure from the power washer.

## HOW MANY DO I NEED?

Measure the length and width of your sauna floor, rounding up to the nearest foot. You can then trim the edge tiles on a table saw to make an exact fit.  $(L \times W) \div 2 =$  number of tiles needed

Example:  $6' \times 5' = 30$  square feet  $\div 2 = 15$  tiles
